1. General:

1.1. Product: Bite-retaining axle for determining the patient's bite situation, easily bendable for better Indication adaptation to the jaw situation.

1.4. Storage conditions:

Storage at room temperature min. +10° C to + 30° C. Protect from direct sunlight. At temperatures below 8° C especially at temperatures in the minus range increased susceptibility to breakage. Protect packages from impact and dropping.

1.5. Contraindication:

In individual cases with incompatibilities / allergies to all components of the wax raw materials mentioned in the safety data sheet. For example kerosenes, beeswax, carnauba wax.

2. Intended use:

Bite-taking wax for use in the dental laboratory, especially in complete and partial denture prosthetics. For taking bites, or determining the bite situation, in the patient's mouth for a short time. The shape of the bite-taking wax can be changed by heating (open Bunsen flame / water basin). The softening or liquefaction of the wax for the actual bite taking in the patient's mouth, is to be carried out with suitable instruments by trained and suitable specialist personnel <u>always</u> outside the patient. Only insert sufficiently large and not too hot pieces into the patient's mouth to avoid swallowing, choking or burning the mucous membranes.

In case of improper use, all warranty and liability claims become void!

3. Risks and dangers in the application:

- 1. Ensure that persons not familiar with the product (e.g. children) do not come into contact with it.
- **2.** Avoid hot wax drops on skin surfaces. Avoid inhalation of wax fumes during burning/burning out (protective clothing as required).
- 3. Wax may only be placed in the patient's mouth for a short time and not permanently.
- **4.** Connect the bite block to the base body in such a way that there is no risk of the patient swallowing or choking.

4. <u>Instruction manual:</u>

4.1. Preparation

Open the packaging on the upper side at the corresponding marking/lid.

4.2. Application

Cut the wax bite block to length with a heated wax knife or suitable instrument and align and adjust it on the working model after slight heating (Bunsen burner/water bath). Model onto the base body and ensure sufficient adhesion using liquefied wax. Small pieces of bite wax should be avoided due to the small bonding surface to the base body.

4.3. After application

Return reusable remnants of the wax to the container, close the lid, protect from dust.

5. Disposal

Can be disposed of in residual waste in accordance with the applicable regulations. The outer packaging can be recycled (Dual System).

6. Durability:

Consumables should generally be used up quickly and immediately within a few months after opening the original packaging. The flavors are food safe and volatilize!
